House Dems Priorities: More Taxes, More Gov't

The Democrats have been quite busy this year working to raise taxes on businesses and the hardworking families of our state, while also working to kill good Republican legislation that passed last year.

Here are some examples of the biggest bills from the session, and how the majority of Democrats voted on them:

- 96% of Democrats voted to raise the gas tax (HB 617)
- 95% voted to increase the fee on home heating oil (HB185)
- 91% voted to raise the tobacco tax (HB659)
- 100% of Democrats voted to repeal some aspects of the Voter ID law passed last year (HB595)
- 95% to repeal Stand Your Ground (HB135)
- 97% voted to repeal the Education Opportunity Tax Credit (HB370)
- 99% voted for to allow the state to accept expanded Medicaid as part of Obamacare (HB271)
- 99% voted to kill Right to Work legislation (HB323)
- 97% of Democrats voted to pass both HB1 and HB2, the Democrat House budget that increases spending by over 10%, and includes \$263m in new or increased taxes.

The New Hampshire House is comprised of 400 individuals, many of whom are very passionate about the issues we face. Many of us have been active in politics for years or even decades and are very knowledgeable about the policy areas we discuss on a regular basis. Despite our experience and confidence in our positions and our message, we must be sure that our words are appropriate before they become part of the public discourse.

Over the last few months, House members from both parties have come under fire for comments, emails, or legislation. This is unfortunate on many levels. Hassan Appoints a Lobbyist

On Monday, Governor Hassan nominated Dennis Caza to the state Racing and Charitable Gaming Commission.

This nomination drew quite a bit of criticism from the NHGOP along with multiple newspapers throughout the state.

Senate Tables HB 370

On Thursday, the full senate voted to table HB370, a bill that would repeal the Education Opportunity Tax Credit program, effectively killing the legislation.

In reaction, House Republican Leader Gene Chandler (R-Bartlett) had the following statement:

“I applaud the Senate for taking action to keep the Education Opportunity Tax Credit in place. The Education Opportunity Tax Credit is brand new and should be allowed the chance to prove itself before the legislature attempts to repeal it. Figures contained in the proposed House budget indicate that this program does not cost the State anything, therefore repealing it does not make any financial gain. Secondly, it allows parents to explore and be better able to afford education opportunities they may not otherwise have access to. Why some legislators want to take away this opportunity is beyond me. We need to make sure families have the ability to find the educational programs that best suit their children. I look forward to fighting to keep this program alive so families can share their stories once scholarships are awarded. Education choice should not be limited to wealthy families. We should have a way to lend a helping hand to less fortunate families to have those same opportunities.”
