	MAJORITY: OUGHT TO PASS 20-0 REPUBLICANS ON THE COMMITTEE UNANIMOUSLY SUPPORTED OTP The motion of OTP passed the House on a voice vote. The motion of OTP/A passed the Senate on a voice vote. The House concurred with the Senate amendment. LEADERSHIP RECOMMENDATION: OVERRIDE GOVERNOR'S VETO

HB148 pg. 1736	limiting the authority of delegates to Article V conventions. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This bill establishes a procedure for the selection of delegates to an Article V convention.
	MAJORITY: OUGHT TO PASS WITH AMENDMENT 12-2 REPUBLICANS ON THE COMMITTEE SUPPORT OTP/A 7-2 WITH 3 ABSENT The motion of OTP/A passed the House on a division vote of 233-76. The motion of OTP passed the Senate on a voice vote. LEADERSHIP RECOMMENDATION: OVERRIDE GOVERNOR'S VETO

HB151 pg. 1736	establishing a committee to study end of life decisions. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This bill establishes a committee to study end-of-life decisions.
	MAJORITY: OUGHT TO PASS 9-7 REPUBLICANS ON THE COMMITTEE OPPOSED OTP 5-4 WITH 3 ABSENT The motion of OTP passed the House on a division vote of 189-161. The motion of OTP passed the Senate on a voice vote. LEADERSHIP RECOMMENDATION: OVERRIDE GOVERNOR'S VETO
